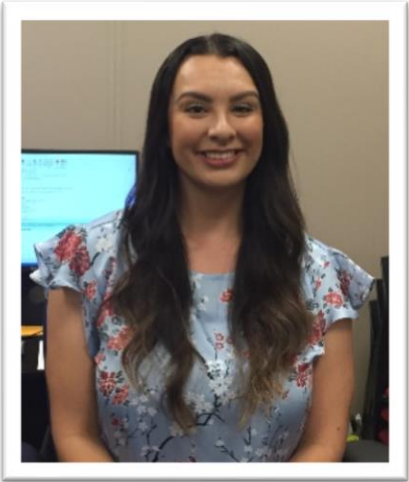


## Alma Ramirez: Fellowship Round III



Alma Ramirez, a Round III WRCOG Fellow, served at Eastern Municipal Water District (EMWD) and had the opportunity to take part in the State Water Project Tour hosted by Metropolitan Water District of Southern California (MWD).

Alma experienced firsthand the history behind the State Water Project by visiting the Oroville Dam, which provides drinking and irrigation water to Central and Southern California; and the Banks Pumping Plant, which is the starting point for the California Aqueduct. According to Alma, “the Fellowship Program has paved the way for *her* career in public service. *She has* gotten the chance to grow *her* network and learn about water policy on a broader

spectrum through opportunities that do not come across very often.”
