Western Riverside County Clean Cities Coalition helps students get excited about the subject of air quality and the impact it has on their future. We provide educational and highly entertaining presentations that will bring the subject to life with captivating images and interactive demonstrations.

The Western Riverside County Clean Cities Coalition's (Coalition) school outreach program is an educational resource designed to develop critical thinking with a focus on finding solutions for improving indoor and outdoor air quality.

Since the programs development, the Coalition has visited various schools and participated in many student environmental education events throughout the region.

The subject matter includes the geographic characteristics of the South Coast Air Basin, the chemical dynamics of ozone, ozone's behavior in the different layers of the atmosphere, indoor and outdoor air quality, energy and motor vehicle pollution (with special emphasis placed on complete versus incomplete combustion), alternative fueled vehicles, advanced technology vehicles and solutions students can implement to remedy air quality problems caused by harmful sources.

During the presentation, students receive an activity guide called *Air Quality Extraordinaire*, which follows the presentation points and includes additional air quality subject matter on a more in depth level. In addition to entertaining activities inside, teachers are able to incorporate the articles and activities into their curriculum. Articles and activities regarding the Clean Air Act, Global Warming and an Alternative Fuel Vehicle design contest are some of the components of the *Air Quality Extraordinaire*.
